Check in for both High School and Junior High Contestants are as follows:

Friday night August 25 5PM-8PM OR Saturday August 26 7:00 and 8:45am

At check in, you will receive a rule book (if you are a new member), laminated back number that you will use all season, Ford Raffle Tickets, Bloomer Tickets, Ad Sales Form and Various other important papers from the state and national office.

MANDATORY MEETING IN THE STANDS

9:00 am – Mandatory Meeting in the stands

This is required for every contestant and parents in the stands. **Don't worry we will give the barrel racers plenty of time to warm up.** We will be going over all the rules of NHSRA that we feel need to be addressed and we will be introducing the student officers, and student event directors. NOMINATION/VOTING for the Student Officer and Event Directors must be completed before August 18, 2023. You will see the voting/nomination QR codes can be found on website and Facebook. Once closed, I will announce the winners and will introduce them and send all the officers emails of what they will need to do (greet people on first day, hang banners at all the rodeos QR codes will be posted on Facebook page and sent out on Remind.

Within this package you will find many important papers:

1. **Checklist check off** – follow this and you will be doing good!
2. This package has either been found on the website www.thsra6.com or has been emailed to you – you will need to print off this package to have the correct forms to upload on your membership portal – SINCE YOU ARE **JH TO HS** there will be a some forms you will need to upload this year and then for the most part will not have to upload again: Social Media, Photo Release, W9, Birth Certificate, - the following forms will be uploaded every year School Form, Contestant Contact Information, your LAST YEARS FINAL REPORT CARD AND CURRENT COGGINS – **Everything will need to be uploaded by August 15 (this helps the secretary can process membership), you will not be able to participate until ALL PAPERS ARE UPLOADED.**
3. **Guideline for JUNIOR HIGH MOVING TO HIGH SCHOOL– DO NOT START A NEW MEMBERSHIP**
Membership application must be filled out on-line at nhsra.com beginning July 1, 2023.
You will pay NHSRA, THSRA and Region Dues on this site.
 - Print out your membership application and minors release form (on portal). Fill out forms, and have them signed and notarized (I am a notary if you are needing help on this).
 - Upload the completed form to your portal (if you are having trouble – reach out)
 - **NEED MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION AND MINORS RELEASE UPLOADED BY AUGUST 15 – SO WE CAN HAVE EVERYTHING ELSE READY FOR YOU AT FIRST RODEO – YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO PARTICIPATE AT FIRST RODEO IF I DO NOT HAVE THESE PAPERS COMPLETED.**
4. **Prospective Members Letter** from the state – very important TEXAS rules, regarding the requirements that must be met.
 - Ford Raffle Ticket – must sell at least 15 tickets (there are incentives for selling more – see Ford Ticket Guidelines)
 - Bloomer Raffle Tickets – must sell 3 tickets (great fund raiser for the Region)
 - Ad Program Sales (state requires a \$50 minimum)
 - **Donation/Sponsor Letter** it is never too early to start trying to get sponsors!
 - **IF AN EVENT DOES NOT HAVE AT LEAST 10 CONTESTANTS IN THAT EVENT, A SADDLE WILL NOT BE AWARDED.** A sponsor would have to sponsor this event for a saddle to be awarded. If a sponsor is not secured the Event Champion will receive a prize – but not a saddle.
5. **Adult Membership Form** please use the QR code or online – you may pay by VENMO or at the first rodeo we will have a table set up to pay, VENMO @thsra6 – or mail P.O. Box 886, Caldwell 77836

6. Online Rodeo Entry – Equine Events Portal – <https://www.equestevent.com> **AGAIN DO NOT START A NEW PORTAL USE THE ONE YOU USED LAST YEAR** (there are directions in this package) – they are scheduled to go live August 1 (plenty of time to enter – if they go live before I will be posting on website, Facebook and Remind) – THIS WILL BE THE ONLY WAY TO ENTER A RODEO THIS YEAR – YOU MAY PAY WITH CREDIT CARD OR BRING MONEY (cash, check or money order) TO THE RODEO. AFTER THE FIRST DEADLINE OF ENTERING A LATE FEE WILL BE ACCESSED AND YOU WILL NEED TO PAY WITH CREDIT CARD. I realize this will be a learning curve but just think you will be able to enter on your phone! I will be available to help you if you need any help!

MEMBERSHIP SHOULD BE UPLOADED TO NHSRA PORTAL BY AUGUST 15, 2023 – Cutters and Reining Cow Horse must have uploaded before you participate.

DRESS CODE – remember new and old members, every contestant must be in full western attire.

- Cowboy Hat
- LONG Sleeve Shirt (**tucked in**)
- Blue Jeans
- Cowboy Boots
- Back Number on your back (will be given at check in)
- Belt is optional

Dress code is a must anytime you are under the covered arena area (this means inside the cyclone fenced area), even if you are just watching in the stands or standing behind the bucking chutes. This is a NHSRA rule, if you are not in full dress code, you may be disqualified.

Region 6 is offering a SLACK option for only one time use this year in all events except Rough Stock only ran on Saturday – Chute Dogging and Steer Wrestling only ran on Sunday – all other events are available – it will be a \$150 fee per rodeo you run slack in – if you choose to run in SLACK your Saturday run will be ran at the beginning of each event then we will start the Sunday Runs – you will have 1st run on your stock if you choose this so there may be some stock reran on Saturday before we finish the pen. When entering you will choose Slack for your event. **CAN ONLY BE USED ONCE A RODEO SEASON**

Complete online rodeo entry from and either pay with credit card or pay at the rodeo (Venmo (@thsra6), cash, check or money order). When late entry begins there will be a \$40 late fee per rodeo added (so could be \$80 for the double weekend).

All fees must be paid BEFORE THE RODEO STARTS OR YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO PARTICIPATE. – THERE IS A REGION 6 VENMO as well @thsra6

MEDICAL AND VET DRAW OUT – will only be honored if you notify the secretary, Anne Dollery at 979-412-2551 (you may text – DO NOT EMAIL) before the rodeo starts. I will need a vet release or a doctors note for fees to be refunded. If your horse was injured during the first rodeo, you must send in a vet release by the following Monday from your vet to receive refund.

Welcome prospective members to the National and Texas High School Rodeo Association. We are pleased to know that you are thinking about becoming a member in this great association where "**The Elite Compete**". Along with the requirements of the region you are thinking about joining, there are a few the THSRA requires, and so there will be no misunderstanding as to what these requirements are, they are listed below:

1. You must be in good standing, under 20 years of age, and be considered a full-time student with passing grades in 70% of classes taken. Any student attending a **private, home-school, year-round school or correspondence school**, must show proof of full-time status (passing 70% of classes) and the grade report must be a professional, computer generated document with the signatures of the teacher(s) for each subject. Any of these types of schools must be a state accredited school/program. If there are any questions, you must get pre-approved **ONE (1) MONTH PRIOR TO DEADLINES** through the THSRA State Office by calling **936-590-4447**. All students, even the ones in public school, will be required to turn in a report card or transcript with their membership application, at mid-term and at the State Finals. Any questionable documents of public, private, home, year-round or correspondence school received at deadline times will result in ineligibility of points for a minimum of two (2) rodeos, until the problem is worked out. **Any documents that are falsified will result in immediate disqualification from the association.**

2. You will be required to sell **fifteen (15) Truck Raffle tickets** by December 2023 and have these returned to your region secretary. For every five (5) tickets sold, you will receive one (1) free ticket.

3. You will be required to sell three **(3) \$50 Bloomer Trailer Raffle ticket** by December 2023 and have this returned to your region secretary. High school members will receive one (1) free ticket with membership and one (1) free ticket for every three (3) tickets sold.

4. You will also be required to sell at least **one (1) \$50 State Ad** for the THSRA State Finals program. For any additional ads sold, the member will receive 25% commission on the additional ad amount and your region will receive 20% commission once the total sales has reached \$350.00.

THSRA members selling the most total ads and sponsorships will receive the following awards:

1st place - Trophy saddle (must have a minimum of \$3,000 in ad sales)

2nd place - hand crafted silver/rawhide breast collar and head stall, unless the member sells over \$3,000 in ads. If your ads total over \$3,000, you will receive a gift certificate for a trophy saddle

3rd place - choice of hand crafted silver/rawhide breast collar or headstall

4th place - choice of hand crafted silver/rawhide breast collar or headstall

5th place - deluxe travel bag with hand-tooled leather logo "THSRA"

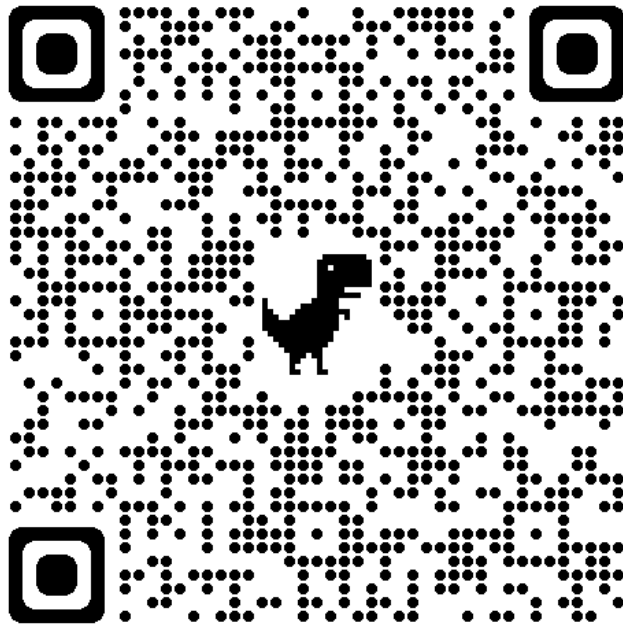
