At check in, you will receive a rule book (if you are a new member), laminated back number that you will use all season, Ford Raffle Tickets, Bloomer Tickets, Ad Sales Form and Various other important papers from the state and national office.

MANDATORY MEETING IN THE STANDS

9:00 am - Mandatory Meeting in the stands

This is required for every contestant and parents in the stands. **Don't worry we will give the barrel racers plenty of time to warm up.** We will be going over all the rules of NHSRA that we feel need to be addressed and we will be introducing the student officers, and student event directors. NOMINATION/VOTING for the Student Officer and Event Directors must be completed before August 18, 2023. You will see the voting/nomination QR codes can be found on website and Facebook. Once closed, I will announce the winners and will introduce them and send all the officers emails of what they will need to do (greet people on first day, hang banners at all the rodeos QR codes will be posted on Facebook page and sent out on Remind. Within this package you will find many important papers:

- 2. This package has either been found on the website <u>www.thsra6.com</u> or has been emailed to you you will need to print off this package to have the correct forms to upload on your membership portal SINCE YOU ARE **NEW TO HS** there will be a some forms you will need to upload this year and then for the most part will not have to upload again: Social Media, Photo Release, W9, Birth Certificate, the following forms will be uploaded every year School Form, Contestant Contact Information, your LAST YEARS FINAL REPORT CARD AND CURRENT COGGINS **Everything will need to be uploaded by** <u>August 15 (this helps</u> the secretary can process membership), you will not be able to participate until ALL PAPERS ARE UPLOADED.

3. Guideline for NEW JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL-

Membership application must be filled out on-line at nhsra.com beginning July 1, 2023.

You will pay NHSRA, THSRA and Region Dues on this site.

- Print out your membership application and minors release form (on portal). Fill out forms, and have them signed and notarized (I am a notary if you are needing help on this).
- Upload the completed form to your portal (if you are having trouble reach out)
- NEED MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION AND MINORS RELEASE UPLOADED BY AUGUST 15 – SO WE CAN HAVE EVERYTHING ELSE READY FOR YOU AT FIRST RODEO – <u>YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO PARTICIPATE AT FIRST RODEO IF I DO NOT</u> <u>HAVE THESE PAPERS COMPLETED.</u>
- 4. **Prospective Members Letter** from the state very important TEXAS rules, regarding the requirements that must be met.
 - Ford Raffle Ticket must sell at least 15 tickets (there are incentives for selling more see Ford Ticket Guidelines)
 - Bloomer Raffle Tickets must sell 3 tickets (great fund raiser for the Region)
 - Ad Program Sales (state requires a \$50 minimum)
 - **Donation/Sponsor Letter** it is never too early to start trying to get sponsors!
 - IF AN EVENT DOES NOT HAVE AT LEAST 10 CONTESTANTS IN THAT EVENT, A SADDLE WILL NOT BE AWARDED. A sponsor would have to sponsor this event for a saddle to be awarded. If a sponsor is not secured the Event Champion will receive a prize – but not a saddle.
- 5. Adult Membership Form please use the QR code or online you may pay by VENMO or at the first rodeo we will have a table set up to pay, VENMO @thsra6 or mail P.O. Box 886, Caldwell 77836

- 6. Online Rodeo Entry Equine Events Portal <u>https://www.equestevent.com</u> (there are directions in this package) they are scheduled to go live August 1 (plenty of time to enter if they go live before I will be posting on website, Facebook and Remind) THIS WILL BE THE ONLY WAY TO ENTER A RODEO THIS YEAR YOU MAY PAY WITH CREDIT CARD OR BRING MONEY (cash, check or money order) TO THE RODEO. AFTER THE FIRST DEADLINE OF ENTERING A LATE FEE WILL BE ACCESSED AND YOU WILL NEED TO PAY WITH CREDIT CARD. I realize this will be a learning curve but just think you will be able to enter on your phone! I will be available to help you if you need any help!



- If a member does not know their password, they can click "Forgot **Password**?" to receive an email with a link to reset their password.



When entering you will choose Slack for your event. **CAN ONLY BE USED ONCE A RODEO SEASON**

All fees must be paid BEFORE THE RODEO STARTS OR YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO PARTICIPATE. – THERE IS A REGION 6 VENMO as well @thsra6

MEDICAL AND VET DRAW OUT – will only be honored if you notify the secretary, Anne Dollery at 979-412-2551 (you may text – DO NOT EMAIL) before the rodeo starts. I will need a vet release or a doctors note for fees to be refunded. If your horse was injured during the first rodeo, you must send in a vet release by the following Monday from your vet to receive refund.

 MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Welcome prospective members to the National and Texas Junior High Rodeo Association. We are pleased to know that you are thinking about becoming a member in this great association where "**The Elite Compete**". Along with the requirements of the region you are thinking about joining, there are a few the TJHRA requires, and so there will be no misunderstanding as to what these requirements are, they are listed below:

1. You must be in good standing, under 16 years of age, and be considered a full-time student with passing grades in 70% of classes taken. Any student attending a **private**, **home-school**, **year-round school or correspondence school**, must show proof of full-time status (passing 70% of classes) and the grade report must be a professional, computer generated document with the signatures of the teacher(s) for each subject. Any of these types of schools must be a state accredited school/program. If there are any questions, you must get pre-approved **ONE (1) MONTH PRIOR TO DEADLINES** through the TJHRA State Office by calling **979-412-2551** All students, even the ones in public school, will be required to turn in a report card or transcript with their membership application, at mid-term and at the State Finals. Any questionable documents of public, private, home, year-round or correspondence school received at deadline times will result in ineligibility of points for a minimum of two (2) rodeos, until the problem is worked out. Any documents that are falsified will result in immediate disqualification from the association.

2. You will be required to sell **fifteen (15) Truck Raffle tickets** by December 1, 2023 and have these returned to your region secretary. For every five (5) tickets sold, you will receive one (1) free ticket.

3. You will required to sell three (3) \$50 Bloomer Trailer Raffle ticket by December 1, 2023 and have this returned to your region secretary. (Please note some regions may require to sell more.)

4. You will also be required to sell at least **one (1) \$50 State Ad** for the TJHRA State Finals program. For any additional ads sold over \$350, the member will receive 25% commission on the additional ad amount and your region will receive 20% commission. The first \$50 is due by December 1, 2023. **ALL ART WORK IS DUE MARCH 1, 2024**

TJHRA members selling the most total ads and sponsorships will receive the following awards:

1st place - Trophy saddle (must have a minimum of \$3,000 in ad sales)

2nd place - hand crafted Silver/rawhide breast collar and head stall, unless the member sells over \$3,000 in ads.

3rd place - hand crafted silver/rawhide breast collar

4th place - hand crafted head stall

5th place - deluxe travel bag with hand-tooled leather logo "TJHRA"

Everyone will need to fill out the following <u>"Contestant Approval Form"</u> and submit it with or prior to our first entry form.

You will no longer have to get "EACH" entry form signed by the principle or notarized; however, you MUST take this form to your school and have it signed by your superintendent or principle. You will also need to take this form to have it notarized. This form will stand good for your seasons entry forms as long as this form is on file with the secretary. **Entry forms will not be accepted without it on file.** You, your parents or guardians will also have to sign before submitting to secretary.

<u>PARENTS</u>: You will need to check the "X" box for all events that you are allowing your contestant to compete in as well as initial and date this box. If contestant enters an event that has **NOT** been checked by parent approval the computer <u>WILL NOT</u> accept the entry. Therefore, if you are considering entering other events at a later date (such as cutting) then you need to check and approve those events as well.

We are hoping that this will be an easier system for you on entering our rodeos. It will take the hazzle out of taking your entry forms to school every time and trying to find a notary for each entry form.

This system should resolve any problems or issues on entering rodeos <u>on time</u>. Each entry form will still have separate due dates as before as of the postmark date.

As a condition of membership in TJHRA (the "Texas Junior High School Rodeo Association"), the undersigned understands that the Texas Junior High School Rodeo Association requires student members, parent members and adult non-parent members to agree not to post on line any comments about the National High School Rodeo Association, the Texas Junior High School Rodeo Association, and/or its official representatives that are inaccurate, detrimental, threatening, harassing and/or derogatory, as well as to agree not to create unauthorized websites and social media accounts utilizing the Texas Junior High School Rodeo Association name, likeness, logo, etc., whether directly or indirectly.
